June 29th was an important date for VJHPS as it marked their first Annual General Meeting. VJH education rooms 1,2 & 3 were packed with medical staff who came out to elect the new Executive, Dr. Scott Ainslie-President, Dr. Kevin Wiseman-Vice President and Dr. Michael Cooke—Secretary/Treasurer.

Acknowledgements were made to three outgoing executives: Drs. Chris Cunningham; Hamish Hwang; and Russell Williams for their tremendous leadership, hard work, and achievements during the past year.

#### **MSP Care Card Initiative Update**

Frequently, patients present to the Emergency Room for acute care without Medical Services Plan (MSP) BC insurance coverage. They may include BC residents without an active Personal Health Number (PHN), out-ofprovince patients with other provincial insurance, or out-of-country patients with or without travel insurance. These patients may be suffering from life or limb threatening disease or trauma, and urgent medical or surgical care must proceed.

Mechanisms to identify these patients in a timely manner so that the physicians providing care may be compensated financially have occasionally been lacking. Complicating the process, all patients are given a 10-digit "tracking number" which qualifies as a valid PHN in many billing programs. These are uniformly rejected by MSP. This may result in physician dissatisfaction, wasted time tracking down information, disengagement with

> A committee was struck by VJHPS to help guide a plan to improve the processing of these patients, especially BC residents. An initial meeting took place in April 2017 involving representatives from acute care administration, physicians, social work and admitting. Data gathering to determine the scope of the issue will proceed, and will be reviewed in October 2017. Already, progress has been made in identifying out-of-province insured patients and having their policy number printed on the ID stickers found at the back of each patient chart, making it easier for billing practitioners to invoice the correct policy.

> Further work needs to be done to identify BC residents without coverage on admission, and flagging uninsured patients from out-ofcountry, so that processes are engaged and all who are involved in acute care can be adequately compensated.

#### **Perinatology & Paediatrics Activity**

A multidisciplinary team has been gathered to address systemic clinical and operational issues that affect us at Vernon Jubilee Hospital as we practice obstetrics, neonatology and paediatrics. The team consists of an obstetrician, paediatrician, maternity GP, midwife, patient care coordinator RN, and unit manager. Based on predetermined indicators and PSLS events, each flagged chart is reviewed for the patient's entire length of stay, with each team member bringing his/her expertise to the committee in order to enhance delivery of care at this site. This collaborative forum is used as a platform to enhance relationships between all team members, enhance knowledge sharing according to best practices, and to streamline delivery of care in a patient-centered manner.
