2019/2020 Priorities

1. Recruitment and Retention of physicians, dentists, and midwives
2. Physician Wellness
3. Obtaining more control over our environment
 - Improving physician involvement in policy and decision-making with both VJH Local Administration and IHA.
 - Opportunity to work with local VJH Admin, IHA Senior Executive, and Board around capital planning – Capital Equipment LEADS
4. Communication
 - Building pride in VJH
 - More explanations on why physicians should get involved in the VJHPS, why they should care about the FEI – testimonials from physicians that are involved
 - Increase communication within the hospital
 - Increase the communication between our Society members
5. More regional collaboration between Hospitalist Departments in other sites in IHA
6. Form a formal relationship with community physicians and the Divisions of Family Practice
7. Involve Physician Engagement – Jarnail Dail and Dr. Harsh Hundal
8. Create a Community Board to have oversight of the Hospital (members of the Community would provide the oversight)

Representatives from the VJHPS Executive and our Facility Engagement Liaison met with Richard Harding, Health Service Administrator North Okanagan, VJH IH, to discuss successes/challenges over the past year. Strategies on how to engage VJH Administration collaboratively and identify joint priorities were discussed.

At present, VJHPS has **19 projects/activities funded** with a focus on improving patient care and the physician's work environment. Where applicable, VJH administrative liaisons have been identified to work alongside our physician LEADS on these projects/activities, creating an effective DYAD model.
